



**CALLING APPLICATIONS FOR THE POST OF DIRECTOR / CENTRE FOR INDUSTRY AND
COMMUNITY LINKAGES (CICL) (PART-TIME), EASTERN UNIVERSITY, SRI LANKA**

Applications are invited from suitable Academic staff (Senior Lecturer Gr. II and above) of Eastern University, Sri Lanka for the Post of Director/Centre for Industry and Community Linkages (Part-time) at the Eastern University, Sri Lanka.

Introduction

University is an Institution for higher education and regional and national development. The community that belongs to EUSL has not been linked adequately via possible industries. Therefore, establishing a center for industry and community linkages has become necessary. The Council, at its Special meeting held on 29.01.2022, has approved the proposal for establishing the Centre for Industry and Community Linkages. This Centre comes under the purview of the Vice-Chancellor.

Objectives

- I. To prepare and enhance Industrial Linkages with relevant communities via "community capacity building with needed infrastructure developments."
- II. To promote and effectively manage the community resources and the industries to strengthen community linkages through scientific evidence.
- III. To create industrial training and active community participation based on community projects undertaken among undergraduate and postgraduate students.
- IV. To empower the community by fulfilling industrial demands by standard recognized technologies and mechanisms.
- V. To provide substantial inputs to increase the national economy (GDP) and per capita income of individuals in the region.
- VI. To enhance the reputation of the EUSL and increase the stakeholders' social well-being through industry and community linkages.

Eligibility :

The applicant should be an Academic with knowledge and prior experience in the industry and community linkage. Willing to work freely without other commitments is preferable.

Tenure :

This is a part-time assignment for a maximum period of three years.

Remunerative :

An honorarium will be paid as determined by the Council of the University.

The duties of the selected candidate :

- i. To develop a constitution/by-laws for the establishment of this Centre.
- ii. To develop organizational arrangements of this Centre.
- iii. To develop the linkage between the University with Industry and Community.

The Applications are encouraged who have prior experience in the industry and community.
