02. GRADUAND ADMISSION CARDS:

The Admission Card for the Graduand is attached herewith, and <u>you are required to bring</u> the Graduand Admission Card to attend the Annual General Convocation.

03. PARENTS/ GUARDIANS:

- a. Wide Screen facilities will be available for others to view the ceremony from <u>outside the</u> Convocation Hall.
- b. All parents/ guardians are kindly requested to remain seated during the proceedings.
- c. Graduands are not permitted to bring cameras, suitcases, bags, cellular phones or any other article into the Convocation Hall. These restrictions will be strictly enforced due to security reasons.
- d. Toilet and canteen facilities will be made available at the close proximity to the Convocation Hall and at parking areas.

04. PARKING:

THE VEHICLES OF THE GRADUANDS WILL **NOT** BE PERMITTED TO ENTER THE UNIVERSITY SENATE PREMISES. THEY ARE KINDLY REQUESTED TO PARK THEIR VEHICLES IN THE PARKING SLOTS MADE AVAILABLE IN THE FACULTY OF ARTS & CULTURE AND FACULTY OF COMMERCE & MANAGEMENT AREAS.

05. CONVOCATION DRESS:

Male Graduands should wear lounge suit or full National Costume. Female Graduands should wear Saree/ National Costume and their hair should be dressed in a formal manner that would not impede garlanding by the Chancellor.

Female Graduands with long hair should tie it in such a way that would not impede garlanding by the Chancellor.



All Graduands should wear their respective Convocation Cloak

06. CONVOCATION PROCESSION:

Graduands are requested to assemble in the porch of the old Library Complex of the Eastern University Srilanka on time (Session I- 07.30 a.m, Session II- 10.30 a.m, Session-III- 02.30p.m,) "Late comers may not be able to join the procession and participate in the Annual General Convocation".

07. PROCEDURE FOR THE CONFERMENT OF DEGREES:

- a. The Graduands will be presented by the Deans of the respective Faculties.
- b. A booklet containing the list of Graduands will be given to you at the Convocation Hall.
- c. When your name is announced, you should be present in front of the stage presenting yourself to the Chancellor for the conferment of the Degree.
 - You should bow before him and receive the Garland, and thereafter, returns to your seat. You should remain seated until the ceremony is over.
- d. All Graduands are required to rise when the Chancellor rises to declare the closure of the Convocation, and remain standing until the Chancellor's Procession leaves the Convocation Hall.

PLEASE NOTE THAT ALL GRADUANDS IN THE SESSION SHOULD WALK OUT OF THE CONVOCATION HALL AND ITS PERMISES IMMEDIATELY AT THE END OF THE SESSION IN ORDER TO FACILITATE ARRANGEMENTS FOR THE NEXT SESSION.

08. GROUP PHOTO:

A Group Photo session will be arranged immediately after the session ends. Graduates are Requested to assemble in front of the SENATE Building immediately.

Please note that studios will be established by the Authorized Photographer on the Convocation day to enable you to take your photographs outside the Convocation Hall.

09. RETURNING OF CLOAK & GARLAND:

The Graduates should return the Cloak and the Garland to the Academic Affairs Department at the Senate Building on or before 17th October 2022 those who fail to return them on or before the above said date shall have to pay Rs 500.00 per day as a fine.

10. OBTAINING OF DEGREE CERTIFICATES:

Graduates are requested to return their University Identity Card and Record Book to receive their Degree Certificate.

Graduates who have not paid their dues will not be able to collect their Degree Certificate although they return the Cloak and Garland.

- Certificate will be issued from 14th November 2022 onward.
- Please note that the Original Degree Certificate will be issued only to the recipient of the Degree.
